Haystack Crossing Discussion

The DRB review of BlackRock's revised application will start on February 4, 2020. Current plans are to have 10 units of perpetually affordable senior housing and 20 units of perpetually affordable residential housing which our committee fully supports. To show our approval we may forgo our February 5, 2020 meeting and attend the DRB meeting instead.

United Church of Hinesburg Lot Discussion

We received some feedback from the church trustees regarding research they did on the suitability of this lot as a building site. It appears the biggest issue is whether or not the lot can handle an on-site sewage system. George is going to dig into this a bit and also see if he can get a rough estimate on how much a hookup to the town sewage system would cost.

Review Town Owned Land Map for Possible Site

We reviewed Map 11 of the town's Planning and Zoning department for any possible site or sites that could be used for affordable housing. We would need feedback from the town as to whether any of this land is available.

Our committee is now down two members and may be down a third member by next summer. Please let us know if anybody is interested in joining.
