## **Hinesburg Community Police**

- Welfare Check On December 18<sup>th</sup>, an officer responded to Hillview Terrace to check on a woman at the request of her daughter. It was learned that the mother Wconfirm she was okay.
- Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol On Thursday, December 18th, officers on patrol received a report of a vehicle being driven in an erratic manner. She was arrested and transported to the station where she was processed and then cited and released.

At that time, an officer from Shelburne PD and off duty Hinesburg officers also responded. The Vermont State Police was contacted for a canine. After the State Police arrival and a search began, the subject returned to the residence and was detained without incident. The subject was transported to the station, processed and released to his father.
