<u>Discussion of a process to inform the Selectboard about a community request for a Resolution for a Ceasefire</u> -Open floor to community for comments/statements:

Resolution brought forth, as written (see minutes from 3/26/24), by Jennifer (Morgen) Decker

There were 11 guests in person and by Zoom that attended the meeting. Two guests spoke in favor of the resolution and nine spoke against.

Rabbi Edleson shared that acts of hate and antisemitic crime has increased more so than islamophobia however they both exist in VT and are both unacceptable

All community members not in favor expressed concern of increased antisemitism if this resolution as written is brought forth as antisemitism is already a problem in the community including but not limited to youth members Jennifer Decker expressed interest in feedback regarding resolution and provided information on an event

Comments open to committee members: Karen – "what's our vision of how we want to live together" All committee members expressed Karen's sentiment that we are "grateful for the dialog." Enrique and other members concurred that those in the Hinesburg and VT communities should come together and continue the dialog to discuss international and domestic affairs and further the discussion. The DEIB committee is not racial equity group and is focused on Hinesburg policies that are not adhering to a DEI standard.

Discussion by committee members to recommend resolution as written to the Selectboard: Unanimously agree not to move forward with recommendation to the Selectboard

Future actions will be to provide feedback to community members regarding resolutions but to provide guidance and easy accessibility to those who wish to put forth a resolution to the town of Hinesburg
