



hinesburg area recreation trails

russell family trails

Description:

Two miles of foot trails located right in Hinesburg's Village Center. Pleasant woods and fields trails on a working farm that feature a rolling landscape offering several vistas of the village and beyond. Although the trails were not designed with mountain bikes in mind, their use is permitted. Some parts of the Perimeter Trail and some of the interior sugaring trails are suitable for horses. The trailhead is located at the north end of Lyman Park fields. Parking is located off of Lyman Park Road.



Driving Directions:

From Hinesburg Town Hall:

- South on Route 116 for .3 miles
- Turn left onto Lyman Meadows Road
- Follow Lyman Meadows Road for 25 - 50 yards
- Turn left onto Lyman Park Road
- Follow Lyman Park Road into the gravel parking area (facing the back of the Catholic Church)

Trailhead:

From the gravel parking area, cross the Lyman Park fields in a northeasterly direction to the trail head located just beyond the baseball diamond.

Notes:

Please do not park in the Lantman's parking lot, as there are an insufficient number of parking spaces for Lantman's customers.

The Russell family has generously conserved these trails for public use - please respect the farming operation, as farm animals may be grazing in the fields.
