Town of Hinesburg Winter Parking Ordinance

At a duly warned meeting on November 3, 2008, the Hinesburg Selectboard voted to adopt a revised Winter Parking Ordinance, as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle on, in or adjacent to any road or street in a location that would interfere with snow removal during the months of November through March inclusive. Such vehicle may be towed and stored at the expense of the owner.

No person shall park in a municipally owned or maintained parking lot after eleven o'clock p.m. and before 5:30 a.m. during the months of November through March inclusive. If the location of such vehicle interferes with snow removal, it may be towed and stored at the owner's expense.

The Winter Parking Ordinance will become effective on January 2, 2009, unless a petition signed by not less than five percent of the voters of the Town of Hinesburg is filed with the Town Clerk by December 17, 2008, on the question of disapproving the Ordinance. If a petition is received, the Selectboard will warn a special meeting and the voters may vote on that question, pursuant to Chapter 59 of Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated.
