



THE TOWN OF HINESBURG
TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AMENDMENT
ESTABLISHMENT OF SPEED AND SPEED LIMITS

The Selectboard of The Town of Hinesburg, in the County of Chittenden, State of Vermont hereby ordains that the original TOWN OF HINESBURG TRAFFIC ORDINANCE Article 10-6 SPEED and Article 10-13 SPEED LIMITS adopted on August 15, 1988, and as amended from time to time thereafter, is further amended as follows,

Be it ordained as provided by Article 10-11 of the "TOWN OF HINESBURG TRAFFIC ORDINANCE "Article 10-6 Speed" and "Article 10-13 Speed Limits" is hereby amended by deleting all existing language thereof originally adopted August 15, 1988 and effective October 15, 1988 and substituting thereof the following language.

Article 10-6 Speed

This ordinance is adopted by the Selectboard of the town under authority granted by 24 V.S.A. Chapter 59 and 23 V.S.A. §1007

10-6.01 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotated, §1007 it shall be prima facie unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle at any speed in excess of those established by the Hinesburg Selectboard as set forth in this Traffic Ordinance, Article 10-13 Speed Limits, which may be amended from time to time.

10-6.02 The Hinesburg Selectboard shall cause to be erected signs in accordance with the MUTCD, and or under authority granted by 24 V.S.A §2291 (4)

10-6.03 Whenever the Hinesburg Selectboard determines, on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, or in accordance with rules set forth under 23 V.S.A §1007, that a maximum speed limit established by the state statutes or this ordinance is higher or lower than is reasonable or safe, upon all or part of any highway within the jurisdiction of the Town of Hinesburg, such speed limit shall be revised and become an amendment to this ordinance.

10-6.04 Any person who violates or fails to comply with provisions of this article shall be subject to penalty in accordance with State Statutes, including but not limited to speed restrictions on state highways 13 V.S.A 13 §7251. Municipalities; payment to and liability of.

Article 10-13 Speed Limits

10-13.01 By order of the Hinesburg Selectboard, the maximum speed limits on streets and highways within the Town of Hinesburg shall be 35 mph, except as follows:

Shelburne Falls Road- TR#1 – 45 MPH

Richmond Road- TR#2 - 35 MPH and 25 MPH on curves

Charlotte Road- TR# 3 – A maximum speed limit of 30MPH beginning 0.00 ± Miles east at the Vermont Route 116 intersection and extending west to 0.01 ± miles, 0.00 miles west of Stella Drive, and then from this point, 45MPH to the Hinesburg/Charlotte town line.

Silver Street- TR #4 - A maximum speed limit of 30MPH beginning 0.00 ± Miles North at the Vermont Route 116 intersection and extending south to 0.04 ± miles, 0.00 miles north of Timber Pond Road, and then from this point, 40MPH to the Hinesburg/Monkton town line.

Hollow Road- (Hinesburg Hollow) - TR #5 - 45 MPH

Pond Road- TR #6 - 35 MPH

CVU Road (School Road) - TR # 7 – 25 MPH

Leavensworth Road- (Twitchell Road) - TR #8 - 35 MPH

Tyler Bridge- TR #8 - 35 MPH

North Road- TR #9 - 40MPH

Pond Brook Road (Lower Pond Road) TR #10 – 35 MPH

Swamp Road - TR #11 – 35 MPH

Sherman Hollow - TR #12– 35 MPH

Boutin Road –TR #13/42 – 30MPH

Bean Road – TR #14 -25MPH

Place Road – TR #15 - 30MPH

Piette Road - TR #16 - 30MPH

Texas Hill Road – TR #17 - 30MPH

Hayden Hill Road (East and West) - TR #19 – 30MPH

Buck Hill Road West – TR# 20 -30 MPH

Buck Hill Road East (Mountain View Road) TR# 20 - 30MPH

Lavigne Hill Road -TR # 21 – **30MPH**

Beecher Hill Road -TR # 22 – **30MPH**

Baldwin Road – TR # 23 – **35MPH**

Burritt Road -TR #24 – **30MPH**

Drinkwater –TR #25 – **35MPH**

Catchapaw Road – TR #26 – **35MPH**

Isham Road – TR #27 – **35MPH**

Lewis Creek – TR #28 – **25 MPH**

Turkey Lane – TR #29 – **25MPH**

Gillman Road – TR # 30 – **35MPH**

Hines Road – TR #31 – **35 MPH**

Mechanicsville Road TR # 32 - A maximum speed limit of **30MPH** beginning 0.00 ± Miles Southwest at the Vermont Route 116 intersection and extending northerly to 0.03 ± miles, 0.00 miles north of Hawk Lane, and then from this point, **35MPH** to the CVU Road/Pond Road intersection.

Lincoln Hill Road – TR # 33 - **30MPH**

Economou Road (Town Land)–TR #34 – **25 MPH**

Old Route 116 (Girls Road) – TR #35 -**35 MPH**

Wildwood Lane – TR #38 – **35MPH**

Birchwood Drive (Giroux Development) – TR #39 - **25 MPH**

Lagoon Road TR #40 – **35 MPH**

Mill Road (Murray Road) – TR #41 – **30MPH**

10-13.02 Pursuant to 23 VSA §1007 (f) The town of Hinesburg is authorized to establish a speed limit on state highways in the town of Hinesburg where the State of Vermont has enacted speed limits to below 50 miles per hour pursuant to 23 V.S.A. §1003, provided that the speed limit established by the Town is the same as the speed limit established by the State of Vermont.

10-13.03 The Town of Hinesburg has adopted the speed limits on VT Route 116 as signed by the State of Vermont on January 8, 2007 and supersedes the speed limits established July 24, 2006 and prior.

Route 116 Speed and exact location,

A maximum speed limit of 40-MPH beginning 0.10 ± Miles south of TH #20 (Buck Hill Road) (mp 3.85 ±), extending northerly to 0.15 ± miles north of TH-20 (mp 4.10 ±), and then from this point, 30-mph to a point 0.10 ± miles north of TH -43 (Commerce Street) (mp 4.96 ±), and then from this point , 40-mph to 0.08 ± miles north of TH-1 (Shelburne Falls Road) (mp 5.54 ±) Also, a school speed limit of 25- mph, when beacons are flashing; beginning 0.28 ± miles north of TH-20 (Buck Hill Road West) (mp 4.23 ±), and extending northerly to 0.9 ± miles south of TH-4 (Silver Street)(mp 4.37 ±).

ARTICLE EFFECTIVE DATE.

- a. This ordinance shall become effective 60 days after its adoption by the Selectboard. If petition is filed under 2VSA §1973, that statute shall govern the implementation of this ordinance.
- b. The original ordinance adopted on August 15, 1988, shall remain in full force and effect. Adopted the 29 day of October 2018 Hinesburg Selectboard
