Updates were given from Kate on Haystack and Beliveau. Phase 2 of the Town Center was discussed and the board was concerned about the filling in of the floodplain to build. Questions were raised about impacts upstream and downstream to other properties with the alteration of the land. Meg and Kate volunteered to attend DRB meetings when they are scheduled to speak to this concern. The Commission discussed working with the PC to revise river corridor by-laws and felt this would be a good step to take.
