Hinesburg Conservation Commission Minutes

- 4. Discussion about Patrick Brook corridor with Hinesburg Land Trust

Paul W and Andrea representing Hinesburg Land Trust. The Land Conservation Fund was created in 1990s, approx 16K currently available in the fund. Typically, it was funded through a warned item at town meeting, recent years the allocation was reduced to 1.5K and included in general budget line item, not voted on individually. Historically used to leverage other funding sources for land conservation. Most funds released based on recommendation from CC and approval by SB.

Andrea pointed out that the large development projects currently considered in the village growth centers have significant lands that extend beyond the growth center - lands with significant ecosystem values. CC members concurred, and recent analysis of Patrick Brook by Mike Kline, consultant with Fluvial Matters LLC, further supports this proposition.

Next Steps: CC and HLT to meet to discuss vision for lands in question within the Patrick Brook/LaPlatte River corridor

5. Parkinson application

Four-house subdivision off of Pond Road - natural resources at potentially at risk, based on map level analysis; core habitat, forest block, deer wintering area, steep slopes, all identified on the NRI, stormwater runoff concerns.

Drew Lepple, as an adjoining land owner, shared his perspective and concerns
