## Hinesburg Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes Tuesday, August 10, 2021

Conservation Commission members present: Robert Hyams, Darcie Mumley, Liz Doran, Kate Kelly Members of the public present: Tobi Schulman, Nina Friscia, Barbara Forauer

1. Call to order 7:10 PM

- 2. Additions/Deletions to agenda Geprags walk with VT Gas employees will be Aug. 18<sup>th</sup> at 5 PM.
- 3. Public Comment for non-agenda items Tobi Schulman introduced herself.
- 4. Natural Resources Inventory press release Bob suggested putting regular links in FPF in addition to a press release. Kate to ask Pam if there is a way to see how many people view the NRI map. Bob to create and send press release to the Citizen and the Record based on FPF post Liz created.
- 5. Lemay: is there anything that would limit development on future lots? Where is the proposed house placement? Kate to contact Mitch.

Farrell: driveway access to be on existing logging road – it crosses a stream a couple times, weaves around. How much are they planning to clear (to get a view)? DRB may limit envelope. Kate will continue to comment, and will estimate and point out the amount of core forest lost.

Laster: three phases – phase 3 is the most problematic one because it's in the core habitat/priority natural area. Trails also go through some steep areas. Would be good to move phase 3 down the hill, closer to phase 1 or 2. We will all send comments to Liz for her final amendments to the review form. Liz will send form to Mitch prior to DRB hearing Aug. 17. Kate and/or Darcie will attend that hearing.

6. RR1 – suggestions were made to amend the draft letter and recommendations Kate drafted. They included recommendations to edit the Conservation Subdivision Design section of subdivision regulations, and a wider discussion of which areas in Hinesburg are deserving of strong protections.

- 9. Review minutes of July 13, 2021 Liz made a motion to approve the minutes of July 13, 2021, Bob seconded, and motion passed with all in favor.
