June 8, 2021 via Zoom

1. Call to order. 7:03 pm
 2. Public Comment. None.
 3. Additions/Deletions
 4. July 4th – Frank spoke to Larry Munson and he wanted time for his father George to respond regarding using the Munson field for line-up. Tom had asked several weeks ago as he always does and reported they were fine with usage for the parade. Jen confirms GMCS will assist with security at parade line-up as in years past. On-Call Building Services will do trash pick-up at HCS after fireworks, Casella and P&P have been contracted. Rain date is Mon. 7/5. Parade is 12 pm because July 4th falls on a Sunday. Jen confirms Rte 116 closure and Mike Anthony will post signs. All information at www.hineburgrec.com and parade sign-up. Hilly Hobble Foot Race is hosted by Eddy Family on Sat. 7/3. Registration starts at 6 pm in front of HCS and 10k starts at 6:30 pm, 5k at 7 pm and kid's 2k at 7:10 pm. Members will assist with line-up. Jen will keep everyone updated.
