Hi Renee,

I am doubtful the Selectboard would give up ownership of the southern end in exchange for a limited easement based on the fact that they wanted to preserve public access.

As for dedication and acceptance, I am not sure if that applies as we know the town owns the fee. Since the town never went through the process of opening it as a highway (even if the town did go through the process of laying it out as a new road, I think it would be hard to make a finding that doing so is in town's best interest), I think it could be argued that it is a driveway and the town has maintained it as such and could choose to stop doing so or scale back maintenance and plowing.

In case that occurs, it seems there should be some maintenance agreement that if the town stops maintenance, then that becomes the responsibility of the new lots/homeowners collectively.

Hi Todd,

Thanks for your email. Apologies for the delayed response.

We would consider ownership of the portion of the road that runs adjacent to the landfill, subject to a *private* easement to the Town for purposes of accessing/maintaining the landfill. Any private easement would have to contain language requiring the Town to repair any damages caused by its use, among other things.

We are not willing to take over that portion of the road subject to a public easement. The road deadends at private property, and we don't see why the Town would want the landfill or soon-to-beinstalled solar field freely accessible to the general public. Presumably the solar field is going to have to be fenced-in once it's completed.

As for the portion of Observatory that runs from North Road to the observatory's gate, I don't see how we could take over that portion. The Goodriches conveyed the road to the Town in 1991, and the Town has maintained and plowed that main section of the road for over 30 years. I'm sure Judy Cardinal and the observatory group would strenuously object to being charged for road maintenance and plowing at this point. I'm not asserting a position on this one way or the other, but I think one could argue that that portion of the road has long since become a public road by dedication and acceptance.

Having said that, we are happy to engage in ongoing conversations with you, the Selectboard, and/or the Town attorney on this. I'm hopeful we can negotiate a mutually agreeable solution.
