Hi Kate and Bob,

I hope you and yours are well. PR&R, (Mobbs) on Observatory Road, have submitted the final plat application. Here is the direct link: <a href="https://www.hinesburg.org/development-review-board/pages/prr-final-plat-2024">https://www.hinesburg.org/development-review-board/pages/prr-final-plat-2024</a>. It is a lot of information, but they have had to do a lot.

I have commented to them per Orders #8 and #11 about the lot #7 building envelope and the proposed screening. For lots #5 and #8 they have provided a 10-foot buffer between their building envelopes and the edge of wildlife protected areas. For lot #7 the difference for a portion of the building envelope is as little as 3-feet. I commented to them that the building envelope for lot #7 should be reduced to be further from the wildlife corridor area. In addition, the proposed screening between lots #7 and #8 and the wildlife corridor includes six 4-foot diameter shrubs at 28-feet on center and seven 4-foot diameter shrubs at 31.5-feet on center. This does not seem to me to be sufficient. I made other comments on the roads, stormwater, some plan consistency, and more. I look forward to hearing your comments.
