# Meeting Minutes March 9, 2023

**Discussion/Approval of February 9, 2023 minutes:** Jon moved to approve the minutes. Kelsey seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

• LHTF Conservation Easement Encroachment: Todd O. spoke with Gregg Lyman who said that he felt the beaver ponds were threatening his property. No other details on what the perceived threat was. The subject was scheduled but removed from the Feb. select board agenda. Committee agreed that the select board should be informed. Aaron feels that the enforcement is in alignment with VLT trust agreements. Pat feels that and infraction of the conservation should have consequence, per

- conservation easement the town has right to enforce. Pat is going to question Todd about this and will go to a select board meeting to inform the board if necessary.
- Website improvement: Kelsey sent out a list of proposed changes to the website. Discussion regarding Jon Trefry's comments. Chris recommended that the website posted, select board approved management plans and other doc's should be the copy that was actually signed by the select board chair. Tom B. recommended refining the language on hunting seasons. Tom B. moved to approve the changes as discussed. Aaron seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

- **FOTW 2023 Work Plan:** Adam Morse described plans for trails, especially Sheep Thrills, Dragon Tail and Homestead as well as annual leaf blowing and other regular maintenance. Kelsey made a motion to approve the FOTW HTF trail plan as amended and planned group ride. Aaron seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.
- Northern Forest grant for Eagle's Trail: Pat forwarded info regarding grant opportunity which would fit
  really well with the culvert replacement and drainage work to Eagles trail. This could also include some
  general restoration work on some of the other trails specified in our trail plan for this year or into the
  future. Aaron moved to endorse FOTW application for the Northern Forest grant. Tom B. seconded.
  The motion carried unanimously.
